For Our Youth:

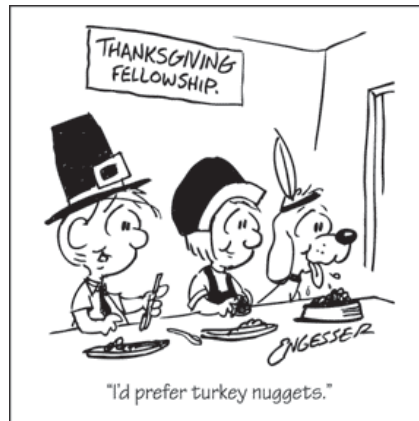
